Choose your software



- Your design can be created in any one or combination of the following applications: Photoshop, Illustrator, or InDesign.

Set your canvas/ artboard/ document size to equal the size of the final print.

- Canvas
- Artboard
- Document

Make sure there is material in the size you are expecting the final print.



Resolution

- All raster image must be at least 150 ppi. 150 ppi is adequate resolution for a printed image. Anything less is unacceptable quality. 300 ppi is the optimal resolution for print.
- Text and vector graphics do not have pixels, therefore, do not have a resolution. They will print at the highest quality the printer is capable of.

Draw a cut line around the image

- Draw a contour cutting line around the image. Make sure that the start and end points of the line meet.

Save your file


- Select File > Save As
- Format: jpg
- Maximum Quality (If exporting from Photoshop, choose Baseline "Standard" as the format option.)

- Create a new swatch with the following options. Use this color as the stroke color of all contour cutting lines.
