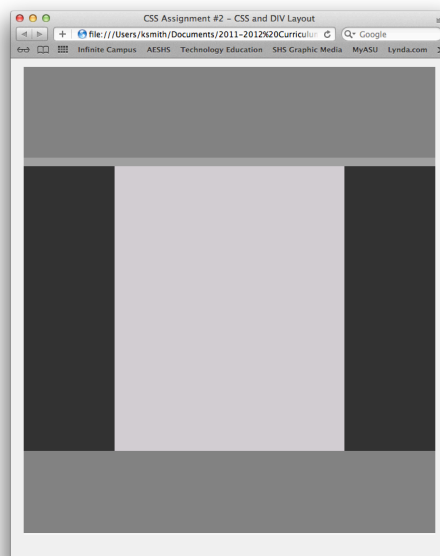
**Directions:** You will be creating a web page layout using divs and css instead of tables.

1. Open a new document in Dreamweaver.
2. Save the document as cssAssign2.html.
3. Insert a div and enter *container* for the id.
4. Inside that div, insert 5 more divs with the following ids:
  - a. header
  - b. nav
  - c. sidebar
  - d. main
  - e. footer
5. Use CSS to define a background color for the page.
6. Use CSS to style each of the divs. You can style each div uniquely by using its id as the selector. The id selector is used to specify a style for a single, unique element. The id selector uses the id attribute of the HTML element, and is defined with a "#". Here is an example of how to style the div with the id *container*.

```
#container {  
    background: #FFFFFF;  
    margin: 20px auto;  
    width: 900px;  
    height: 1024px;  
}
```

Use the example on the next page to determine how to style each div. Make sure to change the background color of each one.

**Extension:** Make another sidebar called *right\_sidebar*. It should be the same size as the sidebar, but on the right side.
