Directions: Download cssProject1.zip from the website.

1. Make a new HTML document in Dreamweaver.
2. Save is as cssProject1.html in the cssProject1 folder.
3. Title the page CSS Project #1 – Animal Photos.
4. Insert a div. Enter *container* as the id.
5. Replace the text "Content for id "container" Goes Here" with "ANIMAL PHOTOS".
6. Insert all nine animal images in the div. Each should have alt text.
7. The HTML for the body of the page should look like this:
