- 2. Save is as cssProject1.html in the cssProject1 folder.
- 3. Title the page CSS Project #1 Animal Photos.
- 4. Insert a div. Enter container as the id.
- 5. Replace the text "Content for id "container" Goes Here" with "ANIMAL PHOTOS".
- 6. Insert all nine animal images in the div. Each should have alt text.
- 7. The HTML for the body of the page should look like this:
