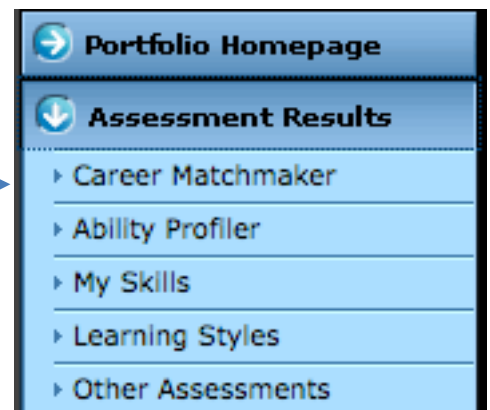
It is the branch of engineering that involves the production and usage of heat and mechanical power for the design, production, and operation of machines and tools.
