





Statement of Problem

To design a 50,000 square foot library with a small park and café for the Arlington Heights community. The structure of the library will be cinderblocks while the café will have a steel structure with two walls made of glass and one wall made of dry wall. The existing 30,800 square foot parking lot will be divided into a smaller parking lot and an area for the park and café. The existing 5,832 square foot parking lot will be left as is and used for employee parking. The site is located at 2020 Northwest Hwy in Arlington Heights, Illinois. The total cost of the project is not to exceed \$10 million and must be completed by March 8, 2010.
