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Designs Built For the Long Run

STATEMENT OF PROBLEM

To design an approximately 35, 000 sq. ft. building with a grocery store and an attached café with seating to be used by Whole Foods Market, Inc., a grocery store chain based out of Austin, TX. The café can be owned by Whole Foods or under the ownership of a separate chain such as Starbucks, Panera Bread, etc. in a cooperative manner. The existing structure made of concrete block, a former Mercedes Benz dealership, will be used and added on to in order to accommodate the size of the grocery store and other areas. The site at 2020 East Northwest Highway in Arlington Heights, IL will provide parking and storage areas and will have some landscaping around the building, especially in the entrance area. There will also be fencing along the north edge of the site to separate it from the bordering neighborhood. The total cost of the project is not to exceed \$2 million and must be completed by June 1, 2009.
